Jack E. Eakman served as Vue's Chairman of the Board for over 25 years. The annual scholarship contest is open to Vue members who are high school seniors planning to attend college in the fall and those enrolled in college for the upcoming school year.

A total of 4 scholarships of \$500 each will be awarded. (The actual number of awarded scholarships may depend on the number of completed applications received.)

Rules:

Applicant must submit application, essay and photo by deadline.

Applicant must be a member of the credit union.

Essays will be judged on the basis of originality, clarity, meaningful content, and accurate presentation of facts.
